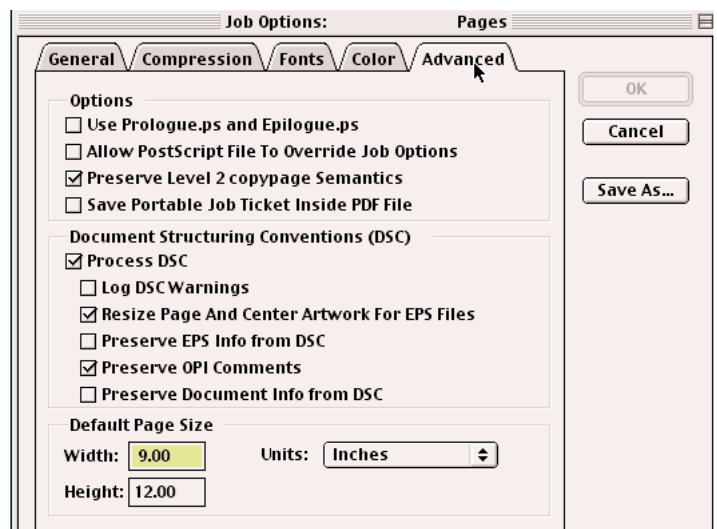
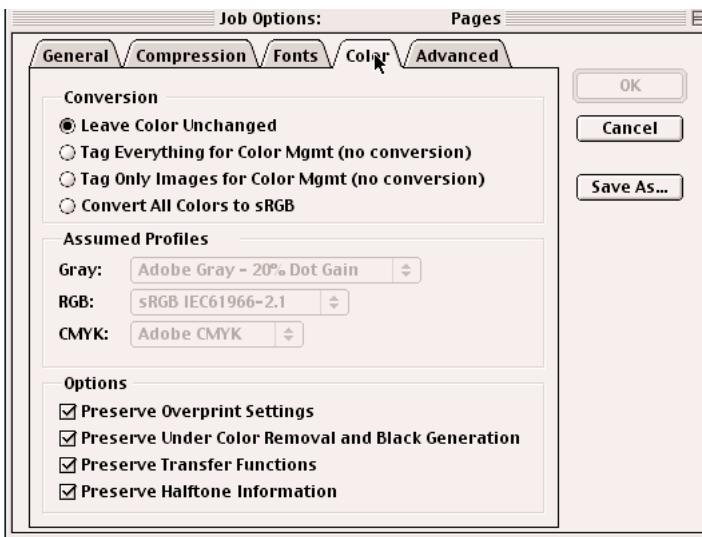
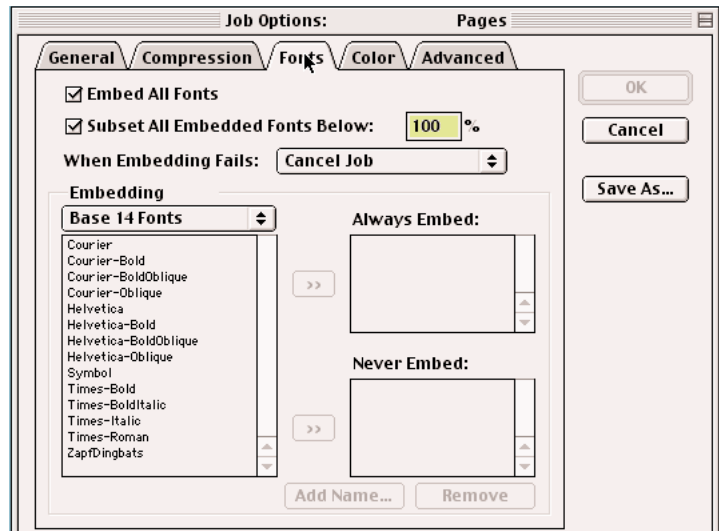
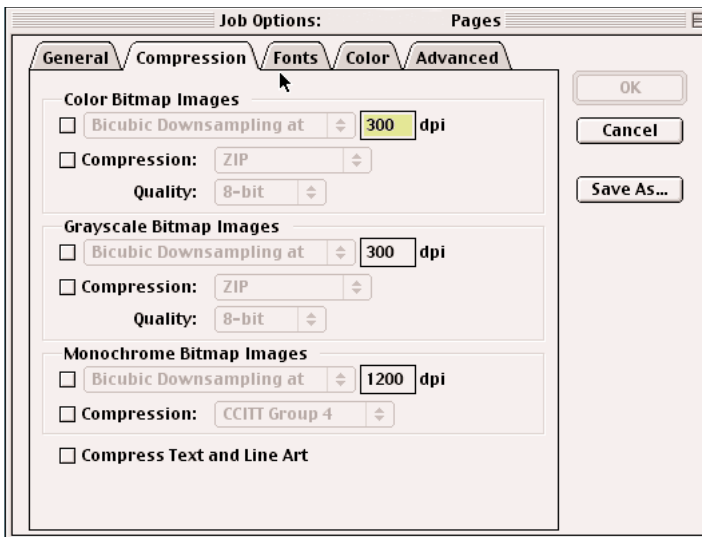
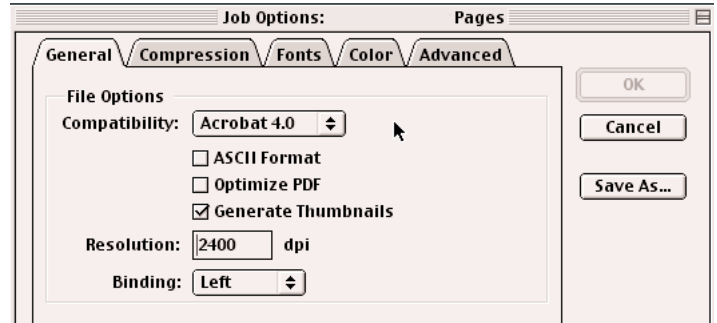
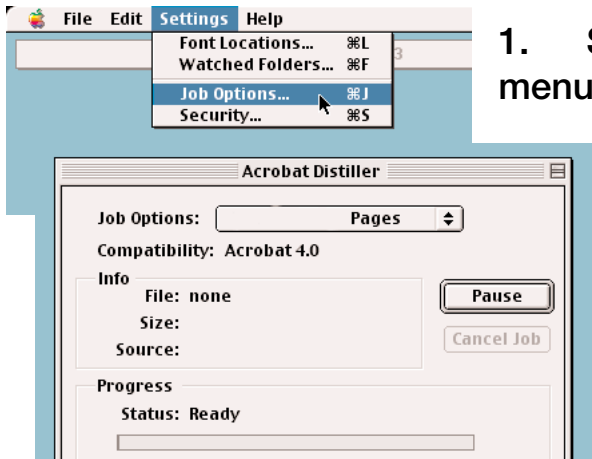


Creating Acrobat PDF from postscript using Adobe Acrobat Distiller

1. Select Job Options from the Settings pull down menu. The following are Job Option settings that are to be used when distilling PS files. See the following page for further explanation.



The settings on the previous page are recommended suggestions for reliable output. They can be altered by referring to Distiller documentation where information on each of the settings can be found. All customer generated PDF files are to be checked by viewing in Acrobat before the files are submitted. The high resolution preview of a PDF viewed in Acrobat at 400% is a reasonably accurate representation of what the final output will look like. Any file format or variation of PDF needs to be tested before a complete job is submitted. Below is an example of a PS file created using the settings from the PS file creation documentation. The page shows trim marks offset 0.125" with a full 0.125" bleed on all four sides. Closer inspection will reveal the image quality.
